- ✓ They are used after verb to be and before other verbs; or at the end of the sentence.
 - ✓ We cannot use sometimes, occasionally, hardly ever, and never with negative verbs.
- ✚ Always/ every week, once a week/ twice a year, normally, generally, every three months, hardly ever, never, sometimes, occasionally, often/ usually, normally, three times a week, every Saturday, every couple of weeks.
