Abstract	<p><b>The subject of this thesis is based on information and data collected in the province of Nineveh in 1984. Three types of farms specializing in the cultivation of grain, such as wheat and barley, have been adopted in this research. The only difference between the three types of farms that has been taken into account is that, the first type is located in an area with guaranteed rain, the second almost guaranteed and the third is not guaranteed. This contrast in the nature of the rain is reflected on the amount of productivity and thus on the amount of gross income. The period that has been chosen for the purposes of this study is the post-agrarian reform era in Iraq.</b></p>
