Abstract	<p>Divorce is one of life's most stressful experiences. When people get a divorce, it requires a period of mourning .Some of the reasons the process is so painful are because it involves money, being alone, and sometimes children. Many children from divorced families become more aggressive than others in schools, in communities, etc.</p> <p>This study has been conducted to make a comparative between China and Iraq, in order to see if children's behaviours from two different countries influenced by the parents divorces. In fact, for a total of 60 children who joined the questionnaire by their teachers who answered the questionnaire, 30 kids from kindergarten in Nanjing and 30 kids from Baghdad, constituted the main data of the study.</p> <p>Descriptive statistics indicated that the divorce is a principal factor affecting kindergarten children's aggressive behavior, also that everywhere in the world the children's behavior are influenced by parental separation spite of cultures difference as compared between China and Iraq kindergarten's children .</p>
