- 7. There is direct correlative relationship statistically significant between post-traumatic stress disorder and methods of adjustment.
- 8. There is reverse correlative relationship statistically significant between Psychological Social Adjustment and methods of adjustment.
- There is reverse correlative relationship statistically significant betweenPsychological Social Adjustmentand symptoms associated with post-traumatic stress disorder.
- 10. There is direct correlative relationship statistically significant betweenmethods of adjustment and methods of adjustmentand symptoms associated with post-traumatic stress disorder.
- 11. The feelings of anger and outrage towards those accused with terrorist actions obtained the highest ratio of (68.7%) of the symptoms associated with

post-traumatic stress disorder.
