This is why the experiment of the social union was chosen to be studied in detail , to shed light on its beginning and the stages this union has gone through and how it ended.</p> <p>The present study consists of an introduction , three chapters and a conclusion .</p> <p>The first chapter consists of a historical introduction that shows the most important political developments in Egypt starting with the period prior to the first world war until the year of 1961 . This chapter sheds light on the important political developments Egypt had gone through , especially the evolution of the National Union which led to the appearance of the Social union .</p> <p>The second chapter deals with the subject of the social union during the years 1961 – 1970 , and the announcement of the National League and the establishment of the third political construction which is embodied by the Arabic social union . This chapter also deals with the constitutional situation of the Arabic social union and its relation with the political authority .</p> <p>The third chapter tackles the role of the organizations within the framework of the social union starting from the year 1970 until 1976 .
